

How do I report an act of bullying?



Definition of bullying according to Olweus: Bullying is aggressive behavior that is intentional and that involves an imbalance of power. Most often, it is repeated over time.

Remember one of our school rules is that we must report an act of bullying to an adult at home and/or school. Here are a few ways.

1. Fill out a bullying form using the "Bully Box" in our school office.

5. Simply tell an adult.
